TENNIS RULES PLAYERS SHOULD KNOW

- 1 You cannot call a **double bounce** on your opponent.
- 2 You can't call a **foot fault** unless you've warned your opponent, tried to get an official, and it's clearly visible from your side of the court.
- You may not catch or stop a ball before it bounces.
- 4) If you served first in a set tiebreak, your opponent will serve first in the next set.
- If a racket is dropped or a shoe comes off, play on!
- 6 You win the point **if the serve hits your opponent** before it bounces or if the ball hits a player before it lands out.
- 7 If you win the toss you can choose (1) serve or receive (2) end of court, or (3) defer/require your opponent to make the choice.
- 8 You should always give your opponent(s) the benefit of the doubt when making line calls.
- In order to claim any hindrance, you must stop play immediately.

10 If a ball hits a permanent fixture (like a scoreboard or bench) and lands in the correct court, the ball is out.
